COVID-19 UPDATE - FEBRUARY 2, 2021

Owego, NY – Tioga County Legislative Chairwoman Sauerbrey reported the following Tioga County COVID-19 Statistics:

- **2,553 Confirmed Cases** – Total confirmed cases, to date.
- **389 Individuals in Mandatory Quarantine** - These are individuals who have had close contact with someone who has tested positive, but is not displaying symptoms for COVID-19; or individuals who traveled outside of New York State.
- **2,242 Recovered** – Total number of individuals who had a confirmed case of COVID-19 and are now symptom free that meet the criteria to be released from isolation.
- **245 Active Cases**
- **66 Deaths**

This data is a snapshot of data provided by Tioga County Public Health. Tests are administered via various agencies and as well as processed by many laboratories. Test results are reported upon our receipt.

Tioga County Legislative Chairwoman Sauerbrey deeply regrets to inform the community that another person has passed away from COVID-19 complications. This was reported as a non-nursing home related death on February 1, 2021. Chairwoman Sauerbrey states, "Our sympathies go out to the family and friends of the loved one."
