COVID-19 UPDATE - FEBRUARY 12, 2021

Owego, NY – Tioga County Legislative Chairwoman Sauerbrey reported the following Tioga County COVID-19 Statistics:

- **2,706 Confirmed Cases** – Total confirmed cases, to date.
- **302 Individuals in Mandatory Quarantine** - These are individuals who have had close contact with someone who has tested positive, but is not displaying symptoms for COVID-19; or individuals who traveled outside of New York State.
- **2,381 Recovered** – Total number of individuals who had a confirmed case of COVID-19 and are now symptom free that meet the criteria to be released from isolation.
- **256 Active Cases**
- **69 Deaths**

This data is a snapshot of data provided by Tioga County Public Health. Tests are administered via various agencies and as well as processed by many laboratories. Test results are reported upon our receipt.

Family and small social gatherings and school connections continue to be a leading cause of community spread at this time. Tioga County Public Health is encouraging ongoing social distancing, wearing masks, and staying home if you are sick or experiencing symptoms.
